## 4.2 ACTIVITIES AT GURUVAYOOR CAMPUS

### 1. Introduction:

Kerala, the God's own Country, sanctified by the birth of Adi Sankara, is exalted to the pinnacle as a place, of living without discrimination of caste, colour, gender and creed as influenced by Jagad Guru Shri Shankaracharya's philosophy of Advaita Vedanta. Samskritapranayabhajanam P.T. Kuriakkose Master started Guruvayoor Sahitya Deepika Sanskrit Vidyapeetha at Pavaratty in 1909 and in 1934 UG and PG Courses were started under Madras University, which was later in 1972 taken by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi and rechristened it as SahityaDeepika Sanskrit Vidyapeetha. In 1979 it was renamed as Guruvayoor Kendriya Sanskrit Vidhyapeetha and was shifted to present location in 1983. The New Administrative and Academic block located at Puranattukara was inaugurated by Dr. Murali Manohar Joshi, the then Hon'ble HRD Minister, on 16th August 1998. Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan was raised to the status of a multi campus Deemed University and this institution was renamed as Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Guruvayoor Campus on 7th May 2002. It has been raised to the status as the CENTRAL SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY by the Parliamentary Act in the year 2020.
